

Youth Clinic Details

Cost: \$10 per 50 targets

- Ammo is sold at the club for \$7.50 / box
- We offer 12 & 20 gauge ammo only
- You will need 2 boxes of ammo per night.

**Participants can bring their your own ammo, which must be target loads, 7 1/2 or 8 shot.

Guns: Participants can bring their own guns.

- We can loan 20 gauge and 12 gauge guns.
- All guns used will be inspected for safety.

Safety: Our highest priority at all times!

Eye protection is required—bring your own shooting glasses.

Hearing protection is required, we do offer foam ear plugs for \$.50 / pair.

Shooting Coaches instructions must be followed at all times.

Unsafe gun handling / horseplay will not be tolerated.

Goals of the Clinic

- reinforce safe gun handling habits
- improve shotgun marksmanship skills
- develop proper shooting posture
- learn correct shooting etiquette
- initiate a life long recreational activity
- Most of all—HAVE FUN!

Coaching

One of the most important factors in conducting a successful clinic of this nature lies within the background or expertise of the coaches involved. The 3 primary coaches for this clinic include Greg Johnson, Mike Kintigh and Joe Zuschlag. Greg is an avid, competitive trap shooter who has won numerous State and National shooting titles. Mike has 31 years experience teaching hunter safety courses with SD G.F&P. Joe has coached youth teams in various sports. All 3 coaches are currently certified by the NRA as Shotgun Level I instructors.

Assisting with the coaching are the past and current members of the RCTC Youth Teams. These are experienced youth shooters who have competed at State and National levels. By involving experienced youth shooters in the coaching, we have found participants respond well to someone near their own age and immediately begin to emulate these young coaches.

What's After the Clinic?

Immediately after the Clinic, the RCTC will begin forming and practicing with the 2019 Youth Teams. Participants in the clinic will have the opportunity to take the next step, and begin to shoot competitively. We follow the national youth program conducted under the Amateur Trap Association called **AIM** (Academics, Integrity, Marksmanship). This means a commitment to a team, weekly practice and some in-state travel to competitive shoots. Our RCTC youth teams have a long history of success at the State and National levels. We practice hard, everyone competes, and we have FUN!
